The International Noise Awareness Day

- Event designed and organized for the first time in 1996 by the Centre for Hearing and Communication to promote awareness of the dangers due to long-term exposure to noise and to contrast its effects both on hearing and on public health.
- Opportunity to make children and young people aware of the problems related to excessive exposure to noise and to educate them to listen to sounds and soundscapes, sharing this experience with schools around the world.
- Since 2010, the Italian Association of Acoustics (AIA) has been coordinating INAD activities for Italian schools.











First prize:

Second prize:



Questionnaire's structure


